

Bluebird's choice:

You know how retailers let the customer know they prefer a specific product?

That's what this is regarding the "better" traveling routes to Lost Creek Bluebird at Shook. Google hasn't captured the location. The map on the website is comprehensive about the "T" highway to Lake Wappapello then "D" would be the shortest route. A couple of miles before the "County Road 525/505" the road is closed for construction. There is a well mapped detour taking "Z" to "TT". From "TT" at McGee, go left 5 miles to "County Road 507". Within 2.4 miles you reach "County Road 505". Turn left and the Retreat is at the bottom of the hill. You will know what I mean by hill when you get there! Always known as the "Opalaski Hill" when my dad was alive and living here.

Route 2 from Poplar Bluff: take 60 East to 51 North past Puxico to Arab. Turn left onto "P". Travel about 10 miles to "County Road 507". In 2.4 miles turn right on "505". Arrive at the bottom of the hill.

Route 3 from Poplar Bluff: take 67 North to Greenville. Take "E Highway" to "P Highway" to "County Road 507". Turn right on "County Road 505" and arrive at the bottom of the hill.

Route 1 from Cape Girardeau: Travel southwest to Advance. Take "Highway 91" to Arab. Stay straight on "Highway P" for approximately 10 miles past McGee to "County Road 507". In 2.4 miles turn right on "County Road 505". You are there at the bottom of the hill.
